

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-7

An ORDINANCE of the Council of the Borough of Nesquehoning, Carbon County, Pennsylvania, Amending the CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF NESQUEHONING Chapter 137 Section 31 and Chapter 137 Section 48 and known as THE SNOW EMERGENCY PARKING ORDINANCE.

**Section 137-31 Snow Emergency no parking**

Whenever there is a snowfall between November 15<sup>th</sup> to and including March 31<sup>st</sup>, it shall be unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle or to allow that vehicle to remain parked anywhere on the South side of streets running East and West, except Coal Street, and on the West side of streets running North and South during the snowstorm or the day after until such time as the aforesaid side of the street is cleared from snow at which time cars may again be parked on that side. On Coal Street, there shall be no parking on the North side during the snowstorm and the day after until such time as the snow is cleared from the North side at which time parking may resume on that side of the street.

**Section 137-48 Schedule XV: Snow Emergency No Parking**

This schedule is repealed in its entirety.

As to all other matters the Snow Emergency Parking is hereby ratified and this Amendment shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
