ORDINANCE NO. 2019-7

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF NESQUEHONING BOROUGH, SPECIFICALLY SECTION 10-612 (ORDINANCE NO 2011-4) AND REQUIRING THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF SMOKE, HEAT AND CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS IN LEASED OR RENTED DWELLING UNITS AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Nesquehoning, Carbon County, Pennsylvania, deem it to be in the best interest and general welfare of the citizens and residents of the Borough to require the installation of smoke detectors in rented or leased dwelling units in order to promote public safety and welfare; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough has the authority to regulate property and to enforce the ordinances and codes of the Borough of Nesquehoning under 53 P.S. Section 46202 of the Borough Code.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF NESQUEHONING, THE FOLLOWING SMOKE, HEAT AND CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTOR ORDINANCE::

SECTION 10-612. Enforcement.

Jurisdiction to enforce this ordinance shall be vested in the Fire Chief, Code Enforcement Officer or his designee, Code Enforcement Official, Police Department or emergency personnel provided however, that this ordinance shall not be interpreted so as to prevent any law enforcement officer from enforcing the terms of this ordinance.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption by Borough Council.


